
## PLEASE JOIN US...

The Metrolina Trauma Advisory Committee’s annual 2026 Metrolina Trauma Symposium will be held at The Harris Conference Center, located just around the corner from the Charlotte-Douglas International Airport, minutes from Uptown Charlotte, and Interstates 77, 85, and 485 running nearby. The Metrolina Trauma Symposium is a collaboration between all SEVEN Trauma Centers in the Metrolina Region. These Trauma Centers consist of Atrium Health Cabarrus, Atrium Health Cleveland, Atrium Health Carolinas Medical Center, Atrium Health Levine Children’s Hospital, CaroMont Regional Medical Center, Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center, and Tenet Health Piedmont Medical Center. 


## RULES AND REGULATIONS

All applications must be made on the official application form and include a description of the products or services to be exhibited.

All products to be exhibited must be directly related to the practice of surgery or medicine, education and any related topics. All are subject to approval by the Metrolina Trauma Symposium Committee.

Exhibitors must comply with FDA regulations concerning the exhibition of investigational products and Class III devices.

Exhibitor identification on all signs, graphics and literature must be the company name(s) submitted on the exhibitor application.

Exhibitors may not assign or apportion to others the whole or any part of the space allocated and may not display goods or services other than those manufactured or regularly distributed by the applicant(s).

Exhibitors must set up, occupy and staff their exhibit during all hours the exhibits are open, unless oral scientific presentations are ongoing.

Registration badges will admit exhibitors to continental breakfasts, lectures, and lunches.

All exhibitor personnel must wear registration badges on the exhibit floor. Badges will be provided gratis for two pre-registered personnel per tabletop. Additional individual exhibitor badges are \$100 each per day.

If a company representative would like to receive continuing education credit for the sessions attended, they will need to register as a conference participant
